Approved Practice Setting (APS)

Cheadle Royal Hospital is a GMC Approved Practice setting. IMGs and UK graduates new to full registration, or those returning to the medical register following a long absence from UK practice, are required by the GMC to work initially in an APS. As an APS we offer the following:

- An annual appraisal system which includes your development needs being identified at the commencement of your employment
- A robust clinical governance system
- Regular clinical supervision for doctors
- A clinical tutor
- Support for CPD
